The responses collected by the departments with regard to each course /subject in the end of each semester and in the consolidated form it is submitted to the IQAC annually. The information provided by the students has been kept confidential in the departments in order to arrive to comprehensive results.

The IQAC analyses consolidated students feedback data of the all the departments/ centres' and developed the report. The whole analysed data report of all departments of university is submitted to the higher authorities. The authorities, accordingly, take action as per the suggestions from the students' feedback responses. The total almost 16392 responses from students' feedback form in the session 2019-2020 were collected.







For the effective presentation of the data useful statistical tools like percentage, graphic representation etc. have been used












### **Students Feedback Analysis**

- 1. Majority of the students strongly agreed that teachers completed the entire syllabus within the allocated time frame.
- 2. High per centage of the students strongly agreed that teachers have subject knowledge.
- 3. Majority of the students were happy with communication skills of their teachers.
- 4. Majority of the students responded that their teachers are punctual in class.
- 5. High per centage of the students responded that teachers come well prepared for the class.
- 6. Most of the students responded that teachers encourage them to participate in the class discussion.
- 7. Students agreed that teachers' attitude towards class is friendly and helpful.
- 8. Most of the students agreed that their teachers are available and accessible in the department.
- 9. 75.59 per centage of the students strongly agreed that evaluation process in fair and unbiased.

#### SUGGESTIONS RECEIVED FROM STUDENTS

- a) Research oriented activities should be encouraged at the student's level
- b) Students requested for increase the parking space for vehicles
- c) Students demanded computers and laptops available in the departments to complete the assignments
- d) Despite the Covid -19 pandemic outbreak during the second half of the academic session, the students overall experience with online sessions was quite good. Most of the students found the online classes to very interactive informative and helpful. The students suggested duration of the classes can be increased up to 60 minutes. There should be 10 minutes break between each class.

# **ACTION TAKEN REPORT**

Action has been taken on the constructive sesions offered by the students in the form of sending circulars to departments and by giving directions to heads of the departments, further head of the departments organised meetings with the faculty and students and actions were taken.

- a) Teachers have been trained to handle the sessions online by organising workshops and training programmes online.
- b) Background material and lecture notes have been shared by many teachers with their students by forming small WhatsApp groups/through emails.
- c) Students were given small projects like case studies, field project report and action taken report.
- d) Some of the places which can be utilized for parking has been developed, as many students requested for the same.

- e) University had given the provision of laptop and desktops in many of the social science departments.
- f) The timing of time table was revised for online classes
- g) The break between the classes was given.
- h) It was suggested by the authorities to deliver lecture through PPT / demonstrations or discussions to make lecture more interesting.
