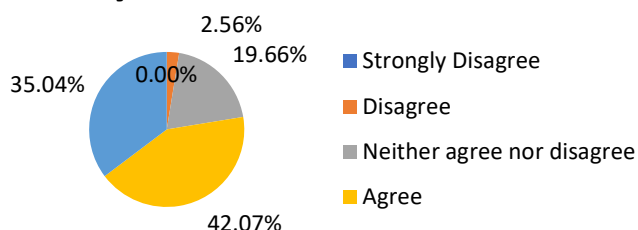

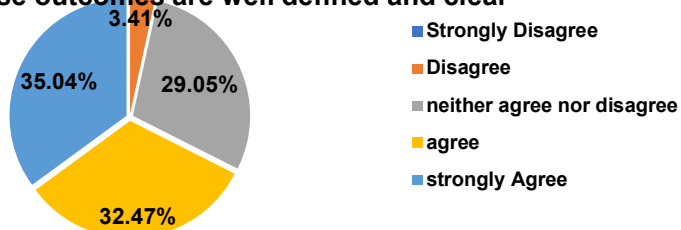

Curriculum and Syllabus are need based



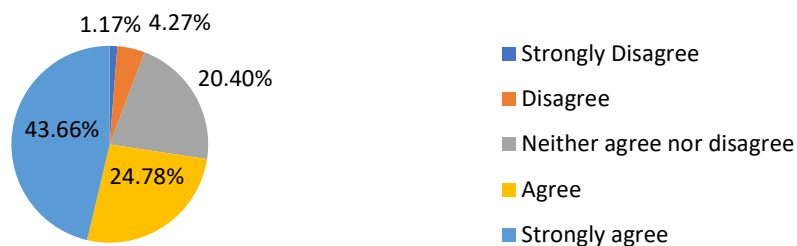

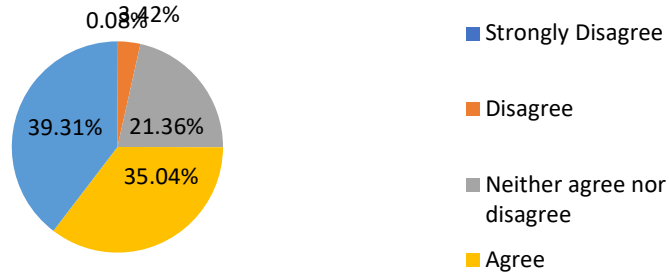

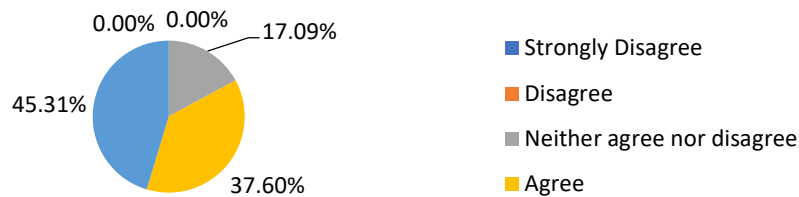

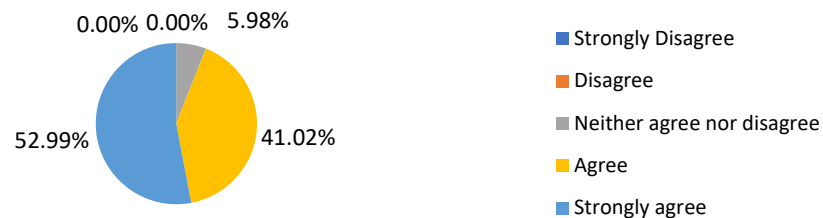

Programms outcome of the syllabus is well defined




SUGGESTIONS GIVEN BY TEACHERS
