

## ANALYSIS OF TEACHERS' FEEDBACK AND ACTION TAKEN REPORT (SESSION 2018-2019)

Panjab University's ultimate aim in taking teachers' feedback is to get useful insights for improvement in all aspects of teaching, learning, assessment and capacity. The IQAC with the help of departments annually collect the feedback and shared the reports of the Teacher's feedback with the authorities i.e Vice Chancellor and DUI of Panjab University Chandigarh. For this purpose, the opinion of teachers was taken to improve the teaching-learning process as well as other curricular activities of the university department. Authorities held chairperson meetings every month and shared the same with the head of the departments.

A total of 98 faculty members of Panjab University filled out the questionnaire on a five-point scale (1- strongly disagree 2- Disagree; 3- Average; 4- Agree; 5- Strongly Agree.) and then data were analysed and interpreted.

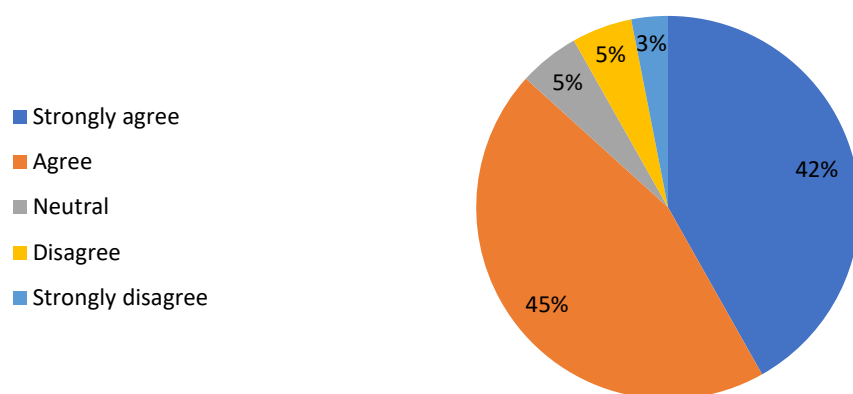

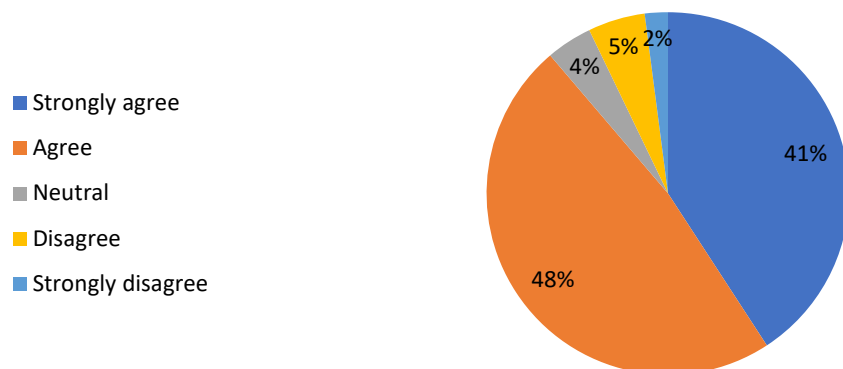

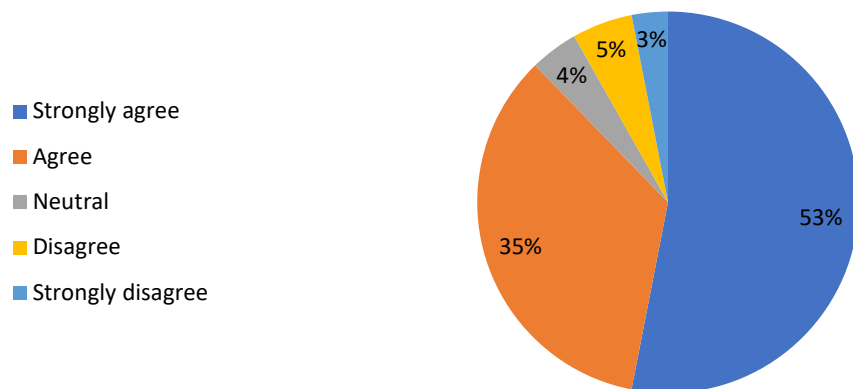

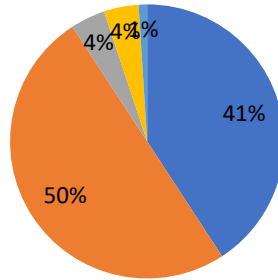

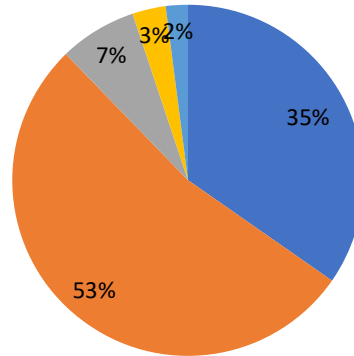

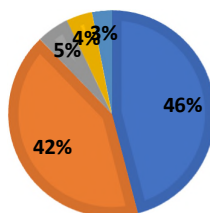

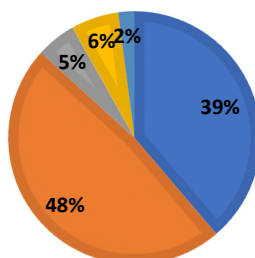

### SUGGESTIONS


- During the time of COVID-19, the maximum number of teachers were unable to take classes due to a lack of knowledge of ICT-enabled classrooms and it was suggested by the teachers to have ICT orientation seminars programmes for the teaching-learning process.
- It is suggested that to increase ICT facilities including campus Wi-Fi enabled.
- Smart classrooms, teaching tools/ laboratory equipment' availability/reading material available for the teaching-learning process
- The curriculum should be improved as per the regulatory guidelines

### Action taken

Formal instructions were circulated to all departments through competent authority for addressing the issues suggested by the teachers through feedback on stressing :

- Various webinars, seminars, and conferences were organised on different themes for the faculty to get familiar with ICT-enabled by the HRDC / CALEM and by the different departments

- The Panjab University, Chandigarh, ZOOM link Webex link, and Google classroom links were developed by the university so that teachers take classes/ seminars and workshops properly.
- Provision of ICT-enabled classrooms and sharing of laboratory resources and technology-based equipment were provided
- Well-furnished student activity centres were established during the period of COVID-19.
