(SESSION 2019-2020)

It is the practice followed in our institution to obtain feedback from the teachers about academic / curriculum design/infrastructure/ **Teaching, Learning and evaluation** etc. for the holistic development of the institution. The important suggestions/comments/remarks given by the teachers to enhance the curriculum, syllabi and other administration activities were collated.

A total of 73 respondents filled out the form on a five-point scale indicating their level of satisfaction [1- strongly disagree 2- Disagree; 3- Aveage; 4- Agree; 5-Srongly Agree).

SUGGESTIONS

- The maximum number of teachers were unable to take classes due to a lack of knowledge of ICT-enabled classrooms. and it was a requirement for the teachers that they should have ICT orientation seminars for the teaching-learning process.
- It was suggested that standards of the syllabus in terms of industry-ready Syllabus be developed
- A culture of entrepreneurship and improvement of employability skills and relevance to real-life applications be developed.

ACTION TAKEN

- For this purpose, actions were taken by the Panjab University, Chandigarh, ZOOM link Webex link, and Google classroom links were developed by the university so that teachers take classes.
- Various webinars, seminars, and conferences were organised on different themes for the faculty to get familiar with ICT-enabled classrooms.
