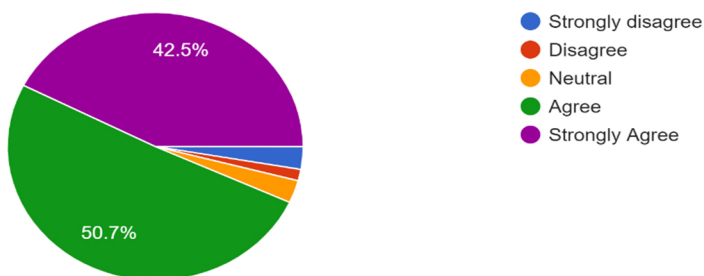
TEACHERS FEEDBACK QUESTIONNAIRE

10. I have contributed to the curriculum and / or syllabus revision.

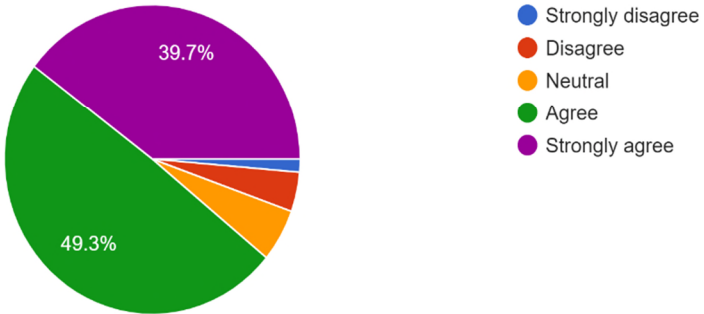

2. The course outcomes are well defined and clear.

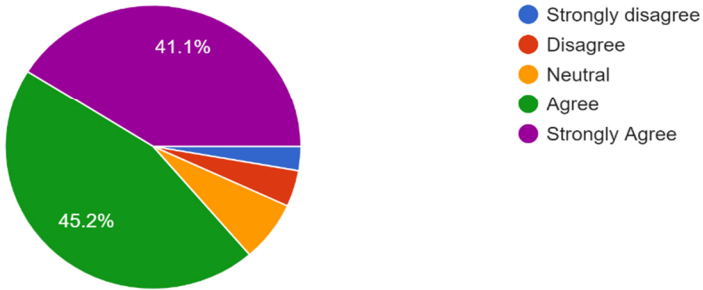

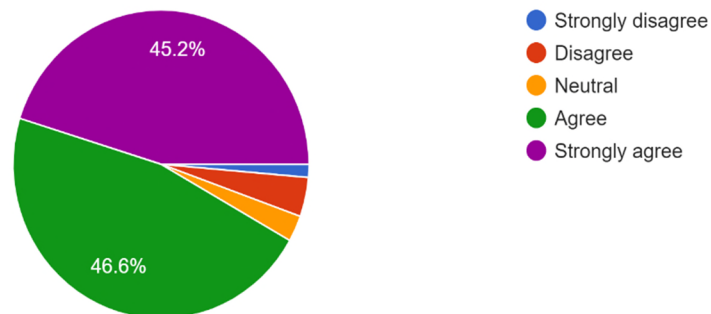


4. The course has good balance between theory and application.

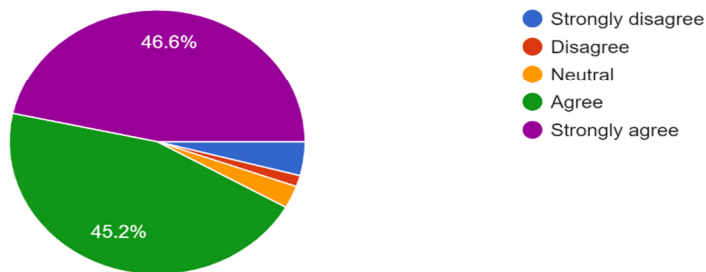

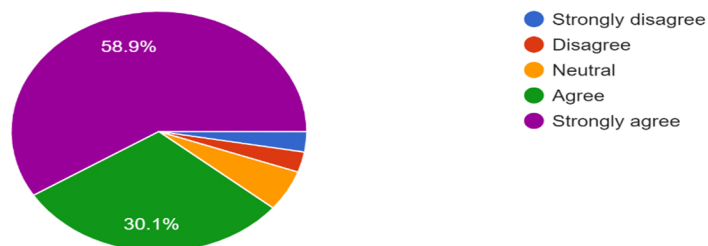

SUGGESTIONS

- The maximum number of teachers were unable to take classes due to a lack of knowledge of ICT-enabled classrooms. and it was a requirement for the teachers that they should have ICT orientation seminars for the teaching-learning process.
- It was suggested that standards of the syllabus in terms of industry-ready Syllabus be developed
- A culture of entrepreneurship and improvement of employability skills and relevance to real-life applications be developed.
