
Annually, the IQAC surveys university alums on the following measures:

- 5) Institutional Relationship with Alumni/ Alumni Interactions






Pie Chart Count of Academic Support





Alumni's indicated that the extensive library collections, laboratories, and classrooms to the student help desk, every facility offered by the university offers an ideal environment for learning. The college also provides ample opportunities for skill development and enrichment activities. Suggestions by Alumni

While the university does a good job of providing a placement cell and often holds workshops and seminars, some alumni have expressed a desire for even more opportunities like these and for more access to career counselling services. Some shared their views departments can organize activites focused on industry and global need-based forums more placement opportunities and seminars and career counselling for the students. Promote peer-to-peer collaboration through the development of online discussion forums or communities where students can share their experiences and offer feedback and advice. Demonstrate a commitment to sustainability by investing in renewable energy sources, green campus initiatives, and creating new opportunities for students interested in environmental studies or business leadership roles related to sustainability innovation projects.

Action Taken Report

After carefully analysing the provided input, appropriate measures were implemented. Training sessions led by a third-party organisation and student coordinators of each department's Training and Placement Cell as well as the university's Central Placement Cell were planned to help students hone their abilities. The university has made significant efforts for collaborating closely with industries, government bodies and NGOs for industrial internships and research collaborations. Setting up mentorship programs that involve experienced faculty

members, alumni and industry professionals. Offering scholarships or fellowships which help students pursue higher studies or conduct independent research. Investing in extensive library facilities with comprehensive digital archives.
